Autumn 1 (Sep - Oct)	<p>Thematic Study: Crime and Punishment <u>Medieval Britain c. 1250–1500</u> Crimes and criminals – who were the criminals, what types of crimes did they commit? Enforcing law and order, e.g. courts. Punishing offenders: types of punishment and effects, e.g. fines, whipping, humiliation. <u>Early Modern Britain</u> c. 1500–1750 Changing nature of crimes and criminals. Enforcing law and order, e.g. different law enforcers. Punishing offenders: types of punishment and effects, e.g. Bloody Code</p>
Autumn 2 (Nov - Dec)	<p>Thematic Study: Crime and Punishment <u>Industrial Britain c. 1750–1900</u> Crimes and criminals. Enforcing law and order, including introduction of police force. Punishing offenders: types of punishment and effects, e.g. transportation, executions. <u>Britain since c. 1900</u> Crimes and criminals. Enforcing law and order. Punishing offenders: types of punishment and effects, e.g. abolition of capital punishment, rehabilitation</p>
Spring 1 (Jan - Feb)	<p>Period Study: Germany 1925- 1955 <u>Germany 1925–33</u> Successes and failures of Weimar Germany. Impact of the depression. Rise of the Nazis and reasons for Hitler becoming Chancellor. <u>Germany 1933–39</u> Actions of the Nazis in government, e.g. Night of the Long Knives in establishing dictatorship. Education, women, children and everyday life. Opposition to the Nazis and increased persecution of minorities.</p>
Spring 2 (Mar – Apr)	<p>Period Study: Germany 1925- 1955 <u>Germany 1939–45</u> Germany at war: the economy and the impact of war on the people <u>Total war 1943–45 and defeat</u> The Holocaust. <u>Germany 1945–55</u> Denazification West German recovery to 1955 and the development of democracy East German development to 1955 and the impact of communism</p>
Summer 1 (Apr - May)	<p>Site or Individual Study Learners are free to choose either an historical figure or a site for this task. Learners will then conduct independent research surrounding their chosen person or site. They will produce a report.</p>
